GENERAL RESPONSIBILITIES

Sultana Education Foundation (SEF), is a private non-profit 501(c)(3) organization based in Chestertown, Maryland that works with over 10,000 students annually, nearly half of which are carried on the namesake schooner *Sultana*, a replica of an 18th century revenue cutter used by the Royal Navy to enforce tax law. The *Sultana* is used as an educational platform focused on teaching History and Ecology.

Deckhand-Educators implement the education programs of SEF under the direction of the Education Director, as well as operating the vessel under the direction of the Mate. *Sultana's* sailing season begins in

March each year and concludes in November. During that season we conduct programs for students of all ages. Spring and Fall focus on late elementary age students on 1.5-3 hour programs. Summer is occupied with multi-day programs, some of which are liveaboard.

- Handle dock lines, set sail, furl sail, work aloft
- Deliver in depth programming and oversee camper safety during summer programs
